ROLE EXPECTATIONS

Scheduling	"Confirm or Decline" emailed service requests from planning center
Times	1st service greeters arrive at 8:30am for Serve Team rally 2nd service greeters arrive at 10:15am for Serve Team rally
Pray	Team Huddle prayer is 30 minutes before the service starts, right after the Serve Team rally.
Welcome Guests	Coming to a new place is intimidating for most people. We serve through being genuinely friendly, trying to remember names, and asking God to help us meet people where they're at.
Thank Guests	Slip out of service a little early to be at the doors (or your assigned spot) to thank people for coming on the way out

TIME COMMITMENT

Welcome Home Team greeters are asked to serve on either the 1st and 3rd Sundays or 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month. For any 5th Sundays of any given month, volunteers are requested for that day and encouraged to serve an extra Sunday but are not expected to.

Commitment terms are from Jan - May, June - Aug, Sept - Dec. Each person will have an opportunity to renew or decline serving for the following term.
